Installation



The Hunter Handheld Control requires an installed compatible receiver to function. Please follow the installation instructions included with the receiver prior to setting up your Handheld Control.

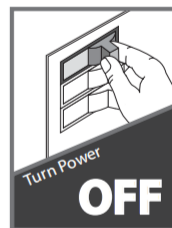
If you are installing multiple remote-controlled fans on the same circuit breaker,

you may need to perform a few extra steps to prevent interference or faulty operation of your remote controls.

1 Turning off the power

Before installation, use the pull chains to set the fan speed to **HIGH** and the light to **ON**. Ensure the power is **OFF** at the outlet box and wall switch location before proceeding with installation.

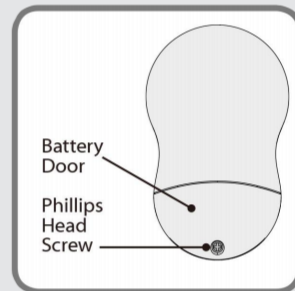


To avoid possible electrical shock, before installing your fan, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breakers to the outlet box associated with the wall switch location.

2 Installing the battery

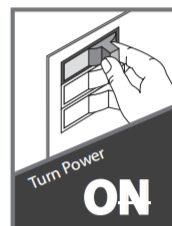
To access the battery compartment, remove the small Phillips head screw that secures the battery door to the remote control.

Replace the used battery with a CR2032 battery when necessary. The battery should be installed with the positive (+) side up.

4 Pair the remote with a compatible receiver.

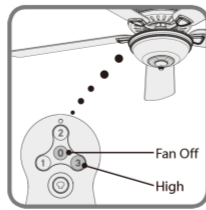
There are two ways to pair the remote control

How to Pair the Remote

Method 1:

Note: The remote must be paired before the fan will operate.

Within 3 minutes of restoring power to the fan, press both the Fan Off button and the the HIGH button for at least 4 seconds. Your fan will turn on low to indicate successful syncing. If it does not, turn off power to your fan, wait 1 minute then try again. If using the transmitter with multiple fans, repeat this process for each fan.



Method 2:

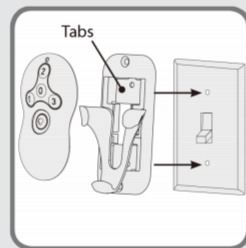
NOTE: To pair your remote, remove the battery door. Cycle power to the fan by turning power off and back on at the wall switch (or circuit breaker if necessary). Within 3 minutes, press the LEARN button on the remote.



To prevent faulty operation, please disconnect power from all other ceiling fans within range while pairing.

Using screws

To install the transmitter cradle, remove the two screws holding your switch cover plate. Do not remove the cover plate. Orient the cradle by lining up the two mounting holes with those on the cover plate. Insert and tighten the screws. Do not over tighten.



Note: For paddle-style switches, break off the tabs on the cradle by pushing outward.

Compatible

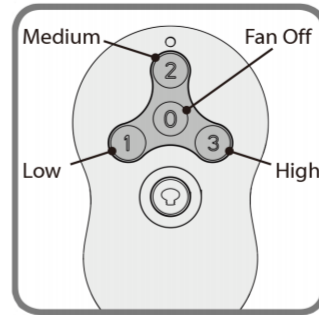
- Compatible with Hunter and Casablanca ceiling fans, as well as other brands.
- Replace Hunter remote 99813, 99392, 99770, 99123, 99122, 99119, 99118, 99198
- The frequency of this remote is 434MHz. If your ceiling fan is 3 Speed and works at the frequency 434MHz, then our remote can work for your ceiling fan.

If you are not sure if this remote can work for your ceiling fan, please purchase a complete kit with a receiver in the store.

Remote Functions



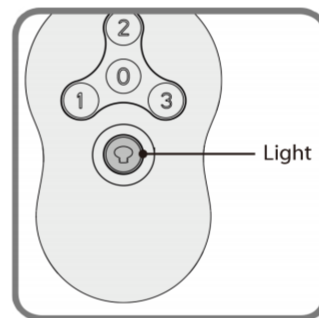
The Fan Off button only turns the fan off. To turn the fan on, press one of the fan speed buttons.

The Safe-Exit Program gives you about thirty seconds of light when you turn the lights off to exit the room before the lights go out. To use Safe-Exit:

- Press the Fan Off button for at least three seconds to initiate the Safe-Exit Mode.
- The lights will flash for visual confirmation.
- The lights will stay on 50% brightness for 15 seconds and then begin to dim. After a total of 30 seconds, the lights will be completely off.

Note: For CFL lighting, the lights will stay on 100% brightness for 30 seconds. After a total of 30 seconds, the lights will be completely off.



Quickly press the Light button to turn the lights off and on. Hold the Light button to raise and dim the light level.

Troubleshooting

Fan will not start

- Make sure the battery is working
- Make sure the power is on at the circuit breaker and the wall switch.
- Make sure that the transmitter and receiver are paired.

Remote control of fan is erratic

- Make sure the battery is installed correctly.
- Install a fresh battery.

Transmitter only works when held at close range

- Change battery.

Lights do not dim

- Check to see if a CFL bulb is installed. The control has a feature that automatically detects CFL bulbs and turns off dimming if a CFL bulb is installed.

CFL bulbs flicker

- Turn the light switch off and back on. Within three minutes, hold down the Fan Off button while pressing the Light button twice. If the problem is not corrected, repeat the process up to three times.
